We write further to your request which was received on 27 July 2021 and which states:

"Please can you confirm the following:

- 1. What is the total number of persons arrested for breach of any Coronavirus Regulations in the IOM from 1st March 2020 to 27th July 2021?
- 2. What is the total number of juveniles out of such arrests?
- 3. What is the total number of persons who have received a custodial sentence for breach of any coronavirus Regulations in the IOM from 1st March 2020 to 27th July 2021?
- 4. What is the total number of juveniles receiving a custodial sentence out of the total referred to in question 3?
- 5. What is the total number of fixed penalty notices issued for breach of any Coronavirus Regulations in the IOM from 1st March 2020 to 27th July 2021? "

While our aim is to provide information whenever possible, in this instance the public authority does not hold or cannot, after taking reasonable steps to do so, find some of the information that you have requested. Please find our responses below:

- 1. Between March 2020 and March 2021 there were 215 arrests for COVID-19 Offences. The Department does not hold information for the period 1st April to 27th July.
- 2. Of the 215 arrests for COVID-19 Offences between March 2020 and March 2021 35 were juveniles (under the age of 18). The Department does not hold information for the period 1st April to 27th July.
- 3. The total number of persons who received a custodial sentence for breach of Coronavirus Regulations in the IOM from 1st March 2020 to 27th July 2021 is 71.
- 4. The Department does not hold this information.
- 5. Between March 2020 and March 2021 there were a total of 37 Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) issued by the Police. The Department does not hold information for the period 1st April to 27th July.
